The SSC WG considered the bottom-up proposal of the new methodology “SSC-NM101: Greenhouse gas emission reduction methodology for reactive compensation in power distribution network” for the second time. Following clarification from the project participant on, inter alia, approaches/assumptions to estimate and monitor the baseline power factor and demonstration of additionality, the SSC WG recommended that the Executive Board of the CDM approve the new methodology “AMS-II.XXX: Emission reduction through reactive power compensation in Power Distribution Network”, as contained in annex 1 to this report.
