



Response to minor issue raised during the completeness check of first verification of PoA – 03223 batch 1:

Dear CDM Team,

Please find our below responses for the issue raised during the completeness check of PoA – 03223 batch 1.

UNFCCC comments:

- 1) The crediting period dates in the submitted Verification/ Certification Report/ Monitoring Report and the registered CPA-DDs of the relevant CPAs/ project view pages are inconsistent.

KBS Response:

The crediting period start dates of individual CPAs are consistent between the submitted VR/CR/MR and Project view pages of individual CPAs, except for the unimplemented CPAs during this monitoring period. The CPAs which could not be implemented during the current monitoring period are listed below and their crediting period start dates had been left blank in the MR as they did not contribute in the emission reductions during this monitoring period.

Now in order to provide the better clarity, the crediting period start dates of unimplemented CPAs as listed below have been left blank in the verification/certification report too to maintain the consistency with the monitoring report.

This is to be noted that the CME had requested the UNFCCC secretariat for the change in the crediting period start dates of some of the CPAs after their inclusions in line to the CDM PS, prior to the publication of consolidated MR. Therefore the start dates of crediting period for some of the CPAs are not consistent with their respective CPA DDs. The email received from UNFCCC



secretariat regarding the confirmation of change of crediting period dates are attached as an annexure with this clarification.

- 2) The Monitoring period dates in the Verification / Certification Report and Monitoring Report are inconsistent (the start date of the MP is indicated as 29 May 2011).

KBS Response:

KBS would like to clarify that the Monitoring Period for the PoA is starting from 30/05/2010 and ending on 31/12/2012 (as per the published consolidated MR), which is consistent within the VR/CR and MR.

However 29th May 2011 is the Monitoring period start date of one individual CPA i.e. 3223-001 (first included CPA at the time of PoA registration) and it is the earliest crediting period start date for a CPA in this Batch 1 delinked MR.

KBS would like to inform that in the Batch 2 delinked MR, the earliest start date of MP is 01st May 2011 for one individual CPA (CPA 3223-0002).

Thus, for maintaining consistency in the 1st Monitoring Period between both the delinked MRs (Batch 1 and Batch 2), the PoA monitoring period has been kept same for the Batch 1 and Batch 2 MR as per para 42 of EB 75 meeting report i.e. starting from 30/05/2010 and ending on 31/12/2012.

The start date of crediting period is verified by the verification team from the confirmation email from UNFCCC dated 09/09/2013 and attached as annexure with this clarification document. The CME had requested the UNFCCC for change in the start of crediting period through mail dated 22/08/2013 and the UNFCCC has confirmed their request on 05/09/2013. The verification team checked the emails and confirmed that the start date of crediting period of CPA 3223-0001 (earliest of all other CPA) as 29 May 2011. Please refer CAR-02(b) of the VR for further clarity on this issue.
