Dear AE/DOE representatives,

Last year the secretariat requested you to provide an updated information on allocation of functions to sites other than the central office of the entity, as provided for by Annex A of the CDM accreditation standard. The information received was considered by the CDM accreditation panel (CDM-AP) and constituted a basis for its assessment planning.

Earlier this year, the CDM-AP decided request all DOEs to elaborate on exact functions performed at the non-central sites to prioritize the assessment plans for 2011-2012.

To facilitate the reporting, a standard declaration form was prepared by the secretariat, also asking for exact addresses of the non-central sites, if any. The addresses of the central office and of the non-centrals sites will be included in the accreditation certificates and published on the CDM website, in accordance with paragraph 12 of the CDM accreditation procedure.

This form is being circulated to all applicant and accredited entities and should also be used for declaring absence of any non-central sites.
