

- I. The above named PoA will assist Nigeria in achieving its sustainable development.
- II. The Department of Climate Change (DCC), as the DNA for Nigeria, authorizes Scatec Solar ASA as the coordinating and managing entity (CME) of the aforementioned PoA in compliance with Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol and its implementing modalities.
- III. That Nigeria's participation in the CDM & CDM-PoA is voluntary.

IV. The Department of Climate Change will cooperate with the CDM Executive Board, the CME and all Project Participants to facilitate the CDM project cycle to the extent possible.
