1. Under the terms outlined, the implementation of the proposed PoA will positively contribute to the sustainable development of Trinidad and Tobago.

2. The parties involved are undertaking the project on a voluntary basis.

In light of the above, the Ministry issues this Letter of Approval for the Petrotrin Oil Fields Associated Gas Recovery and Utilization PoA, exclusively for the purposes stated in Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol, as a requirement for project participants prior to the completion of the validation process by the Designated Operational Entity.
