Object: Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change - Written Approval of voluntary participation from the Italian Designated National Authority for "Replacement of traditional charcoal stoves with efficient EcoRecho stoves in Haiti"

Enel Trade S.p.A. has confirmed that they will be added as project participant in a proposed Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) Project entitled "Replacement of traditional charcoal stoves with efficient EcoRecho stoves in Haiti" and has requested written approval of the Italian voluntary participation in the CDM from the Italian Designated National Authority (DNA) in order to submit this project to the CDM Executive Board for registration.

Enel Trade S.p.A. has provided us with the Letter of Approval by the Host Party's DNA, the Project Designed Document and has submitted the draft Validation Report from Designated Operational Entity AENOR.

The Italian Ministry for the Environment Land and Sea, Department for Sustainable Development Climate Change and Energy, acting as the Italian DNA, hereby declares that:

- (i) Italy ratified the Kyoto Protocol on May, 31, 2002;
- (ii) Italy participates voluntarily in the CDM;
- (iii) to the extent that what is mentioned in paragraphs 1 and 2 may constitute authorisation of Enel Trade S.p.A. participation in the above named CDM project activity, and to the extent that such authorisation is required, this letter may be taken to constitute that authorisation.

In granting authorisation, the Italian DNA has not considered those matters that fall within the competence of:

- Republic of Haiti acting as Host Party in respect of this project;
- AENOR appointed by the project participants as Designated Operational Entity in respect of this project; or
- the CDM Executive Board.
