
The Environmental Protection Agency, acting as Ireland's Designated National Authority in accordance with the Kyoto Protocol Flexible Mechanisms Regulations 2006 [SI 244 of 2006], for the purposes of Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol and the decisions adopted pursuant to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and the Kyoto Protocol, hereby confirms that:

1. Ireland ratified the Kyoto Protocol on 31 May 2002;
2. Ireland participates in the clean development mechanism on a voluntary basis;
3. This letter constitutes approval by the Environmental Protection Agency as required under paragraphs 33 and 40 of Decision 3/CMP.1, Modalities and Procedures for a clean development mechanism as defined in Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol;
4. This letter also constitutes the Environmental Protection Agency's authorisation of CES Carbon Services Ltd as a programme proponent in the *Advanced Energy Solutions for Buildings. Programme of Activities (PoA)* programme.
5. In granting approval, the Environmental Protection Agency has not considered those matters that fall within the competence of:
  - a. Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Oman, Egypt
  - b. TÜV SÜD Industrie Service GmbH

- c. The Executive Board of the Clean Development Mechanism;

To the extent that the issuance and subsequent transfer of certified emission reduction units is in accordance with paragraph 7(1)(b) of SI 244 of 2006, the Environmental Protection Agency does not intend to issue further instruction in respect of these transactions.
