RE: LETTER OF APPROVAL – AFRICAN CLEAN ENERGY SWITCH – BIOGAS (ACES-BIOGAS)

We wish to refer to your request for host country approval for the above Program of Activity (PoA). We note that the purpose of this POA is to stimulate the installation of biogas systems in East Africa to replace traditional thermal energy generation methods. We further note that the POA will be able to encompass all types of biogas systems, depending on the supplier and the user of the biogas, serving both domestic and institutional users.

As the Designated National Authority of Kenya for the Clean Development Mechanism, we wish to confirm that we have reviewed the above-referred PoA. We further wish to confirm that:-

- The Project is approved as a CDM PoA for the purposes of Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol
- The Government of Kenya is Party to the Kyoto Protocol and that participation in CDM project activities is voluntary
- The project will contribute to Kenya's sustainable development
- Africa Clean Energy Switch – Biogas Limited is the coordinating/managing entity for this POA
