This has Reference to your application vide letter dated 26 May 2012 along with a Programme of Activities Design Document (PoA-DD) Version 01 and subsequent letter dated 28 July 2012 seeking a Letter of Approval (LOA) from the Host Country for the above mentioned programme of activities in the Sultanate of Oman .

The CDM- DNA of the Sultanate of Oman confirms the following :-

1. The Government of the Sultanate of Oman has ratified the Kyoto Protocol on 19th January 2005;
2. This Letter of Approval (LOA) is for a Voluntary Participation in the proposed CDM-PoA, however the implementation of the above mentioned programme of activities should not introduce any new commitment or obligation to the Sultanate of Oman other than those contained in the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and Kyoto Protocol; and



3. The proposed CDM-PoA will contribute to the Sustainable Development of the Sultanate of Oman.

After reviewing and assessing the submitted documents of the above mentioned project, this Ministry as the CDM-DNA of the Sultanate of Oman authorize CES Carbon Services Ltd as Project Participant as well as Coordinating Managing Entity (CME) and approves the country participation in the **Advanced Energy Solutions for Buildings. Programme of Activities (PoA)** as Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) programme of Activity (PoA) for the purpose of Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol with the following stipulated conditions:

1. The Coordinated Managing Entity (CME), CES Carbon Services Ltd shall establish its office in the Sultanate of Oman according to the country laws & regulations before including the first CDM Project Activity (CPA) in the Sultanate of Oman;
2. The country laws & regulations particularly regulation for organizing the issuance of CDM project approvals under Kyoto Protocol issued by the Ministerial Decision No. (30/2010) on 21 August 2010 and its amendments shall be adhered to throughout the Project lifetime for both PoA as well as CPA level. Further, CME shall be responsible to pay project fees for each CDM Project Activity (CPA) in the Sultanate of Oman according to the country laws & regulations.
3. A CPA approval letter from the CDM-DNA of the Sultanate of Oman shall be obtained before the implementation of each CPA in the country;



4. The CME, CES Carbon Services Ltd shall obtain necessary permits or permissions from the concerned authorities in the Sultanate of Oman for each CPA in the Sultanate of Oman; and
5. This Letter of Approval (LOA) is not transferable and this Ministry should be informed for any change or variation made in the PoA-DD Version No 01. The Ministry, as the CDM-DNA of the Sultanate of Oman, reserves all the rights to revoke this Letter of Approval (LOA) if CME does not comply with the above mentioned stipulated conditions.

The CDM- DNA of the Sultanate of Oman look forward to see the success of implementation of the present project in order to protect the environment and achieve the Sustainable Development Goals in the Country.
