LETTER OF APPROVAL – KOKO Kenya – Ethanol Cookstoves Program

We wish to refer to your request for host country approval for the above Program of Activity (POA). We note that this Programme of Activities (PoA) is focused on promotion and distribution of bio-ethanol based clean cookstoves to households and/or small and medium scale enterprises (SMEs) in Kenya. We further note that the purpose of this small-scale POA is to achieve widespread commercial use of ethanol as clean cooking fuel by effective use of efficient cooking technologies in low-income households as well as institutions including small-scale industries and commercial set-ups like company offices, retail outlets and restaurants. The KOKO clean fuel solution consists of the “KOKO Cooker” kit, that is, a two-burner ethanol stove and a durable smart canister equipped with an NFC chip that enables tracking of household fuel and “KOKOpoint” ethanol fuel ATMs distributed across the country.

As the Designated National Authority of Kenya for the Clean Development Mechanism, we wish to confirm that we have reviewed the above-referred POA Project Design Document (POA-DD) and the first Component Project Activity design document form - CPA-001: KOKO Kenya – Ethanol Cookstoves Program. We further wish to confirm that:-

- The Project is approved as a CDM project for the purposes of Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol
