The Kingdom of Bhutan accepts the sale and transfer of up to 100% of verified CERs, generated by the CDM project, to any potential CERs buyers during the crediting period of the CDM project, through the transfer of CERs by *The Kingdom of Bhutan* or through any other mechanism accepted by COP/MOP.

The transfer of CERs is irrespective of any legal or other transfer of the CDM project to another operator.


