The DOE indicated that this was not clearly written into the applicability conditions of the methodology, and as some project developers have plans to use such waste for fuel substitution.</p>

<p>Answer to authors of the clarification by the Meth Panel :</p> <p>Please use the space below to provide an answer to the authors of the above query</p> <p>The Meth Panel clarified that this methodology was developed for the use of zero emissions alternative fuels only and recommends that the first bullet of applicability conditions of the methodology is changed as follows: “Fossil fuel(s) used in cement manufacture are partially replaced by renewable energy sources, including renewable biomass or biomass residues where they are in surplus and leakages in other uses of the renewable biomass or biomass residues will not occur”.</p> <p>Project developers are welcome to propose a revision to this methodology in order to consider other types of alternative fuels.</p>
