<p>Answer to authors of the clarification by the Meth Panel :</p> <p>Please use the space below to provide an answer to the authors of the above query</p> <p>The Methodology Panel herewith clarifies that AM0008 is applicable only to industrial fuel switching and does not include fuel switching in stand-alone power stations. Included are fuel switching in processes for heat and/or electricity generation that are located at and directly linked to an industrial process with a main output other than heat or electricity.</p> <p>Rationale: AM0008 is not adequately addressing key issues that arise from large power plants, such as leakage due to competing fossil fuels.</p> <p>Project participants are welcome to propose new methodologies or a revision to AM0008 in order to consider fuel switching in stand-alone power stations.</p>
