<u>Summary of the query:</u> Please use the space below to summarize the request for revision on the related approved methodologies.	
<p>Under the definitions section of the methodology AM0055 Version 2.0.0 the definition of the “Refinery” is stated as:</p> <p>“Refinery- A facility which converts crude oil into high-octane motor fuel (gasoline/petrol), diesel oil, liquefied petroleum gases (LPG), jet aircraft fuel, kerosene, heating fuel oils, lubricating oils, asphalt and petroleum coke.”</p> <p>However, the definition does not include natural gas refining/processing plants as part of refinery.</p> <p>The request for revision aims to expand the applicability of the methodology to natural gas refining plants where the associated gas and/or gas-lift gas is recovered, processed, cleansed and sold to the end customers.</p> <p>There is no change in the baseline and in the project activity hence the equations used to calculate the baseline emissions and project emissions remain the same.</p>
