<p><u>Recommendation by the Meth Panel:</u></p> <p>(a) Please use the space below to provide amendments /changes (in your expert view, if necessary).</p> <p>The original request simply replaced the word “waste cooking oil” with “waste oil or fat”. In this case, however, a procedure to analyze the fate of material would be called for since it is not certain a priori that animal fat produced as a by-product automatically qualifies as a waste. Animal fat such as tallow and lard have its own uses and are traded, though it can be wasted.</p> <p>Therefore, a procedure to analyze the baseline scenario for materials is added in AM0047. The methodology is applicable when the baseline for material is identified as incineration, aerobic or anaerobic decay. If the baseline scenario of the material is other than those specified above (i.e. use as fuel or production of substance), leakage should be taken into account accordingly.</p>	
<p>(b) Please use the space below for providing guidance, as per Para 93 of EB25 Report, on what type of projects need to revise the PDD as a consequence of the suggested revision, if the recommendation is to revise the methodology.</p> <p>Since this revision is an expansion of scope, no revision of previously prepared PDD would be necessary.</p>


