<p><u>Summary of the query:</u></p> <p>Please use the space below to summarize the request for clarification on the related approved methodologies.</p> <p>The DOE refers to the revision of AM0034 Version 4, approved at EB 52, which removed the provision for the exclusion of abnormal campaigns from the historically most recent five campaigns to be selected for the purpose of defining the normal campaign length and identifying the range of operating parameters. The revision makes it necessary for project participants to submit a request for deviation in case an abnormal campaign exists among the five campaigns immediately previous to the baseline campaign.</p> <p>The DOE seeks the clarification from the Meth Panel on whether this deviation requirement of abnormal campaigns is applicable to project activities that were registered as CDM activities under the previous versions (i.e. Versions 1, 2 and 3.4) of AM0034.</p>	
<p><u>Recommendation by the Meth Panel:</u></p> <p>Please use the space below to provide amendments /changes (in your expert view, if necessary).</p> <p>The Meth Panel would like to clarify that this deviation requirement of abnormal campaigns is not applicable to project activities that have been registered as CDM activities under Versions 1, 2 and 3.4 of AM0034.
