Original text from Stakeholder

In line with the Suppressed Demand (SD) Standard (EB62) the methodology requires updating all methodologies. Specific interest in AMSIIC includes dealing with the improved efficiency of the thermal performance of government subsidised formal structures to accommodate low-income households. This revision could be directed at AMSIIAE, but this is specific to new structures and requires monitoring of similar socio-economic conditions, which by definition would exclude suppressed demand. The proposer of this methodology revision realises that the SD Standard could be dealt with in a modular fashion (as with PoAs) or specifically with each methodology. It could also be built up as a specific methodology dealing with the treatment of all SD typologies.

Additional text from Stakeholder submitted 19 Sep 2011:

I have also noted that the revisions I have made to methodology IIC while applicable there could be better applied in the specific methodology IIE.

In which case the revisions could be directly imported under the same headings into methodology IIE.

The small-scale working group of the CDM Executive Board would like to thank the author for the submission.

On the basis of a review of the submission and discussion with the query author, the SSC WG has agreed to not recommend the suggested changes to AMS-II.C. The SSC WG is of the opinion that the proposed

changes are not consistent with the Suppressed Demand Guideline, particularly with respect to definition of minimum service level and identification of applicable technologies which are not hypothetical for meeting particular service levels. It is also noted that there is a call for public input as described in EB 63, [Annex 13 - Draft work Programme On Suppressed Demand](#) and thus the query author may provide further inputs accordingly.
