**Ref: Letter of Approval for CDM project "Talimarjan Clean Energy Generation Project" by the Czech Republic**

PREAMBLE

Whereas:

- A. The Czech Republic has ratified the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change on November 15, 2001.
- B. The Ministry of Environment of the Czech Republic has been appointed as a Designated National Authority (DNA) for the Clean Development Mechanism.
- C. "State Joint Stock Company (SJSC) Uzbekenergo" owns and is implementing "Talimarjan Clean Energy Generation Project".
- D. "State Joint Stock Company (SJSC) Uzbekenergo" and "Synecta a.s." have agreed to the sale and purchase of certified emission reductions generated by the project.


NOW THEREFORE the undersigned as legal and authorized representative of DNA of the Czech Republic declares that:

**DECLARATION:**

- 1. The Czech Republic *approves* the Project as a Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) project in accordance with Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol and the relevant rules, decisions, guidelines, modalities, and procedures and confirms that the participation in the Project is voluntary.

2. The Czech Republic *authorizes* the Purchaser to participate in the Project activity in accordance with the Kyoto Protocol, the Marrakech Accords and the relevant rules, decisions, guidelines, modalities, and procedures.
3. The total number of Emission Reductions generated by the CDM Project for the period 1 July 2015 – 30 June 2025 is presently estimated according to background documentation to 14 000 000 t CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent.
4. This Letter of Approval is made in three (3) originals in English language.
