**DESIGNATED NATIONAL AUTHORITY (DNA) FOR THE CLEAN  
DEVELOPMENT MECHANISM (CDM): LETTER OF APPROVAL FOR  
THE NEW ENGLAND LANDFILL GAS TO ENERGY PROJECT.**

The DNA refers to the application for the DNA's Letter of Approval for the New England Landfill gas to energy Project, submitted to the DNA office by Ener-G Systems Msunduzi (Pty) Ltd, herein referred to as the Project.

South Africa has ratified the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and the Kyoto Protocol and is in compliance with its obligations under these international instruments.

The DNA is the authorised body in South Africa to issue Letters of Approval for CDM projects.

South Africa participates voluntarily in the CDM and in the Project.

The DNA confirms that:

- a. the Project is located on New England Road, Pietermaritzburg; Msunduzi Municipality KwaZulu Natal Province.
- b. the boundary for the project activity is the physical boundary of New England Road, Pietermaritzburg KwaZulu Natal Province. The objective of the project is to collect, destruct and utilize the Landfill Gas (LFG) generated at the New England landfill site which will be flared and used to generate electricity. The installed capacity is

expected to be approximately 2MW and the proposed activity will reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 53, 652 t CO<sub>2</sub>e per annum over a crediting period of 7 years.

- c. the project supports sustainable development in South Africa.
- d. the DNA will cooperate with Ener-G Systems Msunduzi (Pty) Ltd and the CDM Executive Board to facilitate the CDM project cycle, to the extent possible.

The DNA authorises:

- a. the participation of New England Landfill Gas to Energy Project;
- b. by virtue of the South African National ownership, Ener-G Systems Msunduzi Pty (Ltd) becomes the private owner of green house gas emissions reductions generated by this project.

The duration of validity of this Letter of Approval shall be 24 months from the date hereof.


The authorisation granted in terms of this Letter of Approval is conditional upon project development being in accordance with the Project Design Document as received by the DNA.

The DNA retains the right to withdraw the authorisation granted in terms of the Letter of Approval in the event of non-compliance with the Project Design Document.

The granting of this Letter of Approval does not guarantee the registration of the Project as a CDM project by the CDM Executive Board.

By its acceptance of this Letter of Approval, Ener-G Systems Msunduzi (Pty) Ltd indemnifies the DNA against any loss that Ener-G Systems (Pty) Ltd may suffer as a result of project implementation.
