1. Mozambique: Cimentos do Mozambique – Matola Gas Company Fuel Switch Project

2. Norway participates voluntarily in the CDM.


This written approval constitutes authorisation, according to the CDM modalities and procedures, of Carbon Limits' participation in the above mentioned CDM project activities.

In providing this written approval, Norway's DNA has not considered those matters that fall within the competence of:


1. The Host Parties for these CDM project activities;
