As authorized representative of the Designated National Authority for Honduras under the Kyoto Protocol, I further authorize:

- (i) The participation of Azucarera La Grecia, S.A. de C.V. and Mitsui & Co. Ltd. as Project Participants in the Project; and
- (ii) The CDM Executive Board to issue and allocate CERs for any verified greenhouse gas reductions from the Project in the method directed by the Project Participants.

As authorized representative of the Designated National Authority for Honduras under the Kyoto Protocol, I further acknowledge the Project Participants' right, title and interest in and to all of the greenhouse gas emission reductions generated by the Project (and any CERs which are created as result of the Project).
