Has examined the documentation presented by Zero Emissions Technologies S.A requesting the voluntary participation of Spain in the Energy Efficiency measures at the Desalination Plant in Chennai.


Has examined section 12 of the Kyoto protocol,

Has examined paragraph 40 of Decision 17/CP.7 of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.

In accordance with the Third Additional Provision of Law 1/2005, of March 9th by which the greenhouse gas emission allowance trading scheme is regulated. Furthermore, in accordance with the **Spanish National Designated Authority** for the project based mechanisms established under the Kyoto Protocol and finally in accordance with Royal Decree 1031/2007 of July 20<sup>th</sup> which develops the participation framework in the Kyoto Protocol flexibility mechanisms.

#### CONSIDERING:

1. That the Kingdom of Spain has ratified the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change on December 21<sup>st</sup>, 1993 which is part of the Kyoto Protocol, ratified on May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2002.
2. That the Energy Efficiency Measures at the Desalination Plant in Chennai located in India, hereinafter known as the "project", have been submitted by Zero Emissions Technologies, S.A., dated on November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008. Furthermore, that they have been done in accordance with the Third Additional Provision of Law 1/2005, of March 9<sup>th</sup>, by which the greenhouse gas emission allowance trading scheme is regulated. The project is also in accordance with Royal Decree 1031/2007 of July 20<sup>th</sup>, which develops the participation framework in the Kyoto Protocol flexibility mechanisms as well as the requirements established in the clean development mechanism project defined in Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol, the Marrakech Agreements and the subsequent agreements regarding their implementation.

That the Project has been analysed based upon the Project Design Document (PDD) and the relevant documentation provided by Zero Emissions Technologies, S.A. to the Spanish Office of Climate Change with registry entry number 1279 dated on November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008. Furthermore, that the project is in accordance with the terms outlined in this Spanish National Designated Authority approval document.
