

1. China approved the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change on 30 August 2002, and is a Party to the Kyoto Protocol.
2. Power Generation from Coking Waste Heat Utilization Project at Lan County Fengda Coking and Chemicals Smelting Co., Ltd complies with the permission requirements provided for in the Measures for Operation and Management of Clean Development Mechanism Project in China, and assists China in achieving sustainable development.
3. Lan County Fengda Coking and Chemicals Smelting Co., Ltd. is hereby authorized as China's participant to voluntarily participate in and carry out the project activity.
4. Lan County Fengda Coking and Chemicals Smelting Co., Ltd. is permitted to transfer to Trading Emissions PLC that is authorized by the Government of the United Kingdom no more than 650,000 tCO<sub>2</sub>e in total Certified Emission Reductions (CERs).
