Resolution of the Designated National Authority approving the voluntary participation of Spain in the Programme of Activities “Tanzania Renewable Energy Programme” and the participation of the World Bank in the programme.

THE SPAIN’S DESIGNATED NATIONAL AUTHORITY,

Having examined the documentation submitted by the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development acting as the Trustee of the Carbon Partnership Facility (CPF), henceforth “The World Bank” in the application for voluntary participation of Spain in the Programme of Activities (PoA) **“Tanzania Renewable Energy Programme”**,

Recalling Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol,

Recalling paragraph 40 of decision 17/CP 7 of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change,

Recalling paragraph 20 of decisions 4/CMP1 and 7/CMP1 of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and the subsequent decisions,

In compliance with Third Additional Provision of Law 1/2005, of 9th March, regulating the regime for greenhouse gas emission allowances trading, and Royal Decree 1031/2007, of 20th July, developing the participation framework in the Kyoto Protocol flexible mechanisms

CONSIDERING,

1. That The Kingdom of Spain ratified the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change on 21st December 1993, and ratified the Kyoto Protocol thereto on 31st May 2002,
2. That the Programme **“Tanzania Renewable Energy Programme”**, henceforth “the programme”, for GHG emission reductions located in **Tanzania** submitted by the World Bank on **January 30th 2015**, has been presented in conformity with the Third Additional Provision of Law 1/2005, of 9th March, regulating the regime for greenhouse gas emission allowances trading, the Royal Decree 1031/2007, of 20th July, developing the participation framework in the Kyoto Protocol flexible mechanisms and the requirements established for clean development mechanism projects in Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol, the Marrakech Accords and the subsequent decisions,



3. That the programme has been analysed from the programme design document (**PoA-DD**), the CPA1-CDM programme activity for the Mapembasi Hydro Power Project, the CPA2-CDM programme activity for the NextGen Solar Project, and the additional documentation sent by the **World Bank** to the Spanish Climate Change Bureau, with registration number **106/132**, dated **January 30th 2015**, and in the terms expressed in the aforementioned document.

**APPROVES THE VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION OF THE KINGDOM OF SPAIN,
AS PARTY OF THE KYOTO PROTOCOL, IN THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMME:**

Visto el Artículo 12 del Protocolo de Kioto,

Visto el párrafo 40 de la decisión 17/CP.7 de la Convención Marco de Naciones Unidas sobre Cambio Climático,

Visto el párrafo 20 de las decisiones 4/CMP.1 y 7/CMP.1 de la Convención Marco de Naciones Unidas sobre Cambio Climático, así como las decisiones posteriores que lo desarrollan,

De conformidad con la Disposición Adicional Tercera de la Ley 1/2005, de 9 de marzo, por la que se regula el régimen del comercio de derechos de emisión de gases de efecto invernadero, y con el Real Decreto 1031/2007, de 20 de julio, por el que se desarrolla el marco de participación en los mecanismos de flexibilidad del Protocolo de Kioto,

CONSIDERANDO:

1. Que el **Reino de España** ha ratificado la Convención Marco de Naciones Unidas sobre Cambio Climático el 21 de diciembre de 1993, y es Parte del Protocolo de Kioto, que ha ratificado el 31 de mayo de 2002.
2. Que el “**Programa de Actividades (PoA) de Energía Renovable en Tanzania**” (*Tanzania Renewable Energy Programme*) en adelante, el “**programa**”, ubicado en **Tanzania**, remitido por el **Banco Mundial** con fecha **30 de Enero de 2015**, ha sido presentado conforme a la Disposición Adicional Tercera de la Ley 1/2005, de 9 de marzo, por la que se regula el régimen del comercio de derechos de emisión de gases de efecto invernadero, el Real Decreto 1031/2007, de 20 de julio, por el que se desarrolla el marco de participación en los mecanismos de flexibilidad del Protocolo de Kioto y los requisitos establecidos para los proyectos del mecanismo del desarrollo limpio en el Artículo 12 del Protocolo de Kioto, los Acuerdos de Marrakech y las decisiones posteriores que los desarrollan.



3. Que el Programa ha sido analizado a partir del documento de diseño del programa (**PoA-DD**), del documento de actividad del programa (CPA1) correspondiente al Proyecto de Energía Hidroeléctrica de Mapembasi , del documento de actividad del programa (CPA2) correspondiente al Proyecto Solar NextGen, y de la documentación adicional pertinente remitida por el **Banco Mundial** a la Oficina Española de Cambio Climático, con número de registro de entrada **106/132**, de fecha **30 de Enero de 2015**, y en los términos expresados en dichos documentos.


