Whereas:

- A. Sweden has ratified the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change on May 31, 2002.
- B. The Swedish Energy Agency has been appointed Designated National Authority for the Clean Development Mechanism.
- C. *Tricorona Climate Partner AB* ("the Applicant") has applied to participate in the *Sri Balaji 6 MW Non-Conventional Renewable Sources Biomass Power Project*

NOW THEREFORE the undersigned as legal and authorized representative of the Government of Sweden declares that:

## Declaration

- 1 Sweden *approves* Sri Balaji 6 MW Non-Conventional Renewable Sources Biomass Power Project as a Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) activity in accordance with Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol and the relevant rules, decisions, guidelines, modalities, and procedures thereunder and confirms that the participation is voluntary.
- 2 Sweden *authorizes* the Applicant to participate in the Sri Balaji 6 MW Non-Conventional Renewable Sources Biomass Power Project in accordance with the Kyoto Protocol, the Marrakech Accords and the relevant rules, decisions, guidelines, modalities, and procedures thereunder.
- 3 Sweden *affirms* that any public funding for the Sri Balaji 6 MW Non-Conventional Renewable Sources Biomass Power Project does not result in a diversion of Sweden's official development assistance and is separate from and is not counted towards Sweden's financial obligations as a Party.

#### **PREAMBLE**

Whereas:

- A. Sweden has ratified the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change on May 31, 2002.
- B. The Swedish Energy Agency has been appointed Designated National Authority for the Clean Development Mechanism.
- C. Sri Balaji Biomass Power Limited ("Project Entity") owns and is implementing the Sri Balaji 6 MW Non-conventional Renewable sources Biomass Power Project in Chennur Village, Chennur Mandal, Cuddapah district, Andhra Pradesh, India ("The Project"), which aims at utilising biomass to generate electricity that will be exported to a grid system, described in the Project Design Document dated October 25, 2005.
- D. The Project Entity and Carbon Asset Services AB ("The Purchaser") have agreed to the sale and purchase of certified emission reductions generated by the project.


NOW THEREFORE the undersigned as legal and authorized representative of the Government of Sweden declares that:
