- (ii) the State of the Netherlands participates voluntarily in the "Incauca S.A. Fuel Switch from Coal to Green Harvest Residues CDM Project" in Colombia (the "**CDM Project Activity**");
- (iii) the State of the Netherlands, as a Party directly involved in the "**CDM Project Activity**" authorizes the participation of the Netherlands' Ministry of Infrastructure and the Environment (**IenM**), former name Netherlands' Ministry of Housing, Spatial Planning and the Environment ("**VROM**"), as a Project Participant in the "**CDM Project Activity**" and wishes to receive Certified Emission Reductions (**CERs**) in the national registry account: NL-100-8-0 "Netherlands CDM Purchase Programme";
- (iv) the State of the Netherlands hereby also authorizes the participation of the Corporación Andina de Fomento (CAF) acting as trustee for the government of The Netherlands represented by the Ministry of Infrastructure and the Environment (IenM) as a Project Participant in the "**CDM Project Activity**";
- (v) this Written Approval covers the requirements of paragraphs 33 and 40 (a) and (f) of the CDM Modalities and Procedures.



Finally, the State of the Netherlands declares that for the purchase of CERs resulting from this “**CDM Project Activity**”, public funding of the State of the Netherlands is involved. It confirms that this public funding does not result in a diversion of official development assistance and is separate from and not counted towards the financial obligations of the State of the Netherlands in that respect.

- (iv) this Declaration of Approval covers the requirements of paragraphs 33 and 40 (a) and (f) of the CDM Modalities and Procedures


