The Climate and Pollution Agency, being the Norwegian Designated National Authority (DNA) under the CDM, hereby declares that:

- (i) Norway ratified the Kyoto Protocol on 30th May 2002;
- (ii) Norway participates voluntarily in the Clean Development Mechanism;

This written approval constitutes authorisation, according to the CDM modalities and procedures, of Statkraft Norfund Power Invest AS' participation in the above mentioned CDM project.

In providing this written approval, Norway's DNA has not considered those matters that fall within the competence of:


1. The Host Party for the CDM project;

This project is a hydro power project with an installed capacity of more than 20 MW. In accordance with the voluntary harmonised approach to the implementation of Article 11b(6) of Directive 2004/101/EC, this project has provided documentation to the DNA of Norway in the form of an assessment by an independent entity demonstrating that the project is in compliance with the recommendations of the World Commission of Dams

(WCD). The assessment report is based on the seven strategic priorities developed by the WCD.
