The Ministry of the Environment, Climate and Sustainable Development, acting as the Designated National Authority (DNA) for Luxembourg to the UNFCCC Secretariat, declares that the Letters of Approval issued in the name of the Ministry of Sustainable Development and Infrastructure, authorizing it to act as a project participant in projects implemented under the Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol are valid for the Ministry of the Environment, Climate and Sustainable Development, located at 4, Place de l'Europe, L-1499 Luxembourg, for the below enumerated projects due to change of legal name from Ministry of Sustainable Development and Infrastructure to Ministry of the Environment, Climate and Sustainable Development

The change in the name of the Ministry of Sustainable Development and Infrastructure was made after Luxembourg's legislative elections that took place in October 2018. The Ministries of the new Government were formed pursuant to "Arrêté grand-ducal du 5 décembre 2018 portant constitution des Ministères" on 05/12/2018. The competencies relating to climate change were transferred to the newly formed Ministry of the Environment, Climate and Sustainable Development (p.10). The Ministry of Sustainable Development and Infrastructure no longer exists under the new Government.
