<p>One question should be clarified: The critical parameter identified for this project activity is the amount of electricity exported to the grid which is being measured through calibrated meters. The State Electricity Board has the responsibility of calibration and maintenance of the meters. Even though the Verification team is of the opinion that the master instruments used for inspection of these meters has the traceability to the National / International Standards they state that these instruments "cannot be verified since this is responsibility of the RRVPNL" and classify this issue as "limited" which represents a reporting risk.</p>
