LETTER OF APPROVAL - CLEAN COOK-STOVES IN SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA BY ClimateCare Limited

We wish to refer to your request for host country approval for the above Program of Activity (POA). We note that the purpose of this Programme of Activities (PoA) is to reduce the greenhouse gas emissions associated with the production and combustion of charcoal where the wood source is non-renewing in Sub-Saharan Africa. This will be achieved by promoting the design, manufacture, distribution and use of efficient or improved charcoal stoves (ECS) which provide the same service with significantly less fuel than traditional charcoal stoves in common use.

As the Designated National Authority of Kenya for the Clean Development Mechanism, we wish to confirm that we have reviewed the above-referred POA and the Kenyan CPA entitled Improved Jikos Project-CPA02. We further wish to confirm that:-

- The Project is approved as a CDM project for the purposes of Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol
- The Government of Kenya is Party to the Kyoto Protocol and that participation in CDM project activities is voluntary
- The project will contribute to Kenya's sustainable development

- ClimateCare Limited is the coordinating/managing entity (CME) for this POA and that the CME in collaboration with Finlays Horticulture Fairtrade Association will implement the Kenyan CPA

We wish to note and confirm that this project, amongst other issues, will contribute to the overall realization of Kenya Vision 2030, sustainable development and also contribute to the reduction in usage of firewood and charcoal in the target area. It is however to be noted that this project must comply with all the required Kenya national regulatory and/or planning requirements throughout all the phases of implementation.
