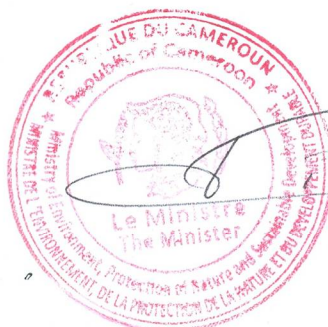

- The Republic of Cameroon ratified the UNFCCC in October 1994 and adhered to the Kyoto Protocol in July 2003;
- The Republic of Cameroon participates in the CDM on a voluntary basis, as well as projects developed within the framework of CDM;
- The project will contribute to sustainable development in the Republic of Cameroon
- The DNA will collaborate with **S2 Services Sarl** and the Executive Board of CDM to facilitate its procedures and to assist whenever need be in the issuance and transfer of Certified Emission Reductions (CER).
- The DNA authorizes **S2 Services Sarl**, to implement the CDM project "NURU LIGHT - CAMEROON" in Cameroon. The Project is developed under article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol and the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC);

As authorized representative of the DNA of the Republic of Cameroon under the Kyoto Protocol, we hereby request the CDM Executive Board to issue and allocate Certified Emission Reductions (CERs) for the qualified and verified efforts of the project under CDM methodologies to **S2 Services Sarl**.

On behalf of the National Committee on Clean Development Mechanism, we hereby issue a letter of approval for the project "NURU LIGHT -CAMEROON" to be implemented as a CDM in accordance to article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol.
