Subject: Grant of Host Country Approval to CDM Project Titled "Foundation Wind Energy-I Limited 50 MW Wind Farm Project".

This is to inform you that the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM), Project Design Document (PDD) for "Foundation Wind Energy-I Limited 50 MW Wind Farm Project", was considered by the Designated National Authority (DNA) in the Ministry of Climate Change.

2. The DNA hereby approves the above mentioned project as:
- a. The project activity is submitted to CDM Cell and aims to utilize a wind power facility to generate zero greenhouse gas (GHG) emission electricity for the Pakistan National Grid, thereby displacing electricity that is relatively carbon intensive and is located on Gharo, Kutti Kun New Island in Taluka Mirpur Sakro District Thatta, Sindh with emission reduction of 88,213 tCO₂eq/yr.
 - b. The project will contribute to sustainable development and improvement of local environmental conditions in Pakistan.
 - c. This approval is for the voluntary participation of the following project participants in the proposed CDM project activity.

3. It may further be noted that Government of Pakistan has got accession to the Kyoto Protocol on 11th January, 2005.
