## INFORMATION NOTE

### **“Riding Together” 9 June 2014**

The secretariat of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), in association with the City of Bonn and the Bike Association of Bonn (Allgemeiner Deutscher Fahrrad-Club Bonn), would like to inform participants to the upcoming United Nations Climate Change Conference to be held in Bonn, Germany from 4 – 15 June 2014, of the organization of a Bike Promenade “Riding Together” during the sessions.

The promenade will be held on Monday, 9 June 2014, beginning at 10.00 a.m, and is expected to last approximately two hours. It will depart from and return to the Maritim Hotel. Heads and members of delegations, as well as of UNFCCC staff are invited to this promenade. The purpose of the promenade is to promote cycling as an environmentally friendly means of transportation and enjoy the wonderful view of the Rhine in a relaxing environment after the first hard week of the sessions.

A limited number of bicycles, generously provided by the Deutsche Bahn, will be available on a first come, first served basis. 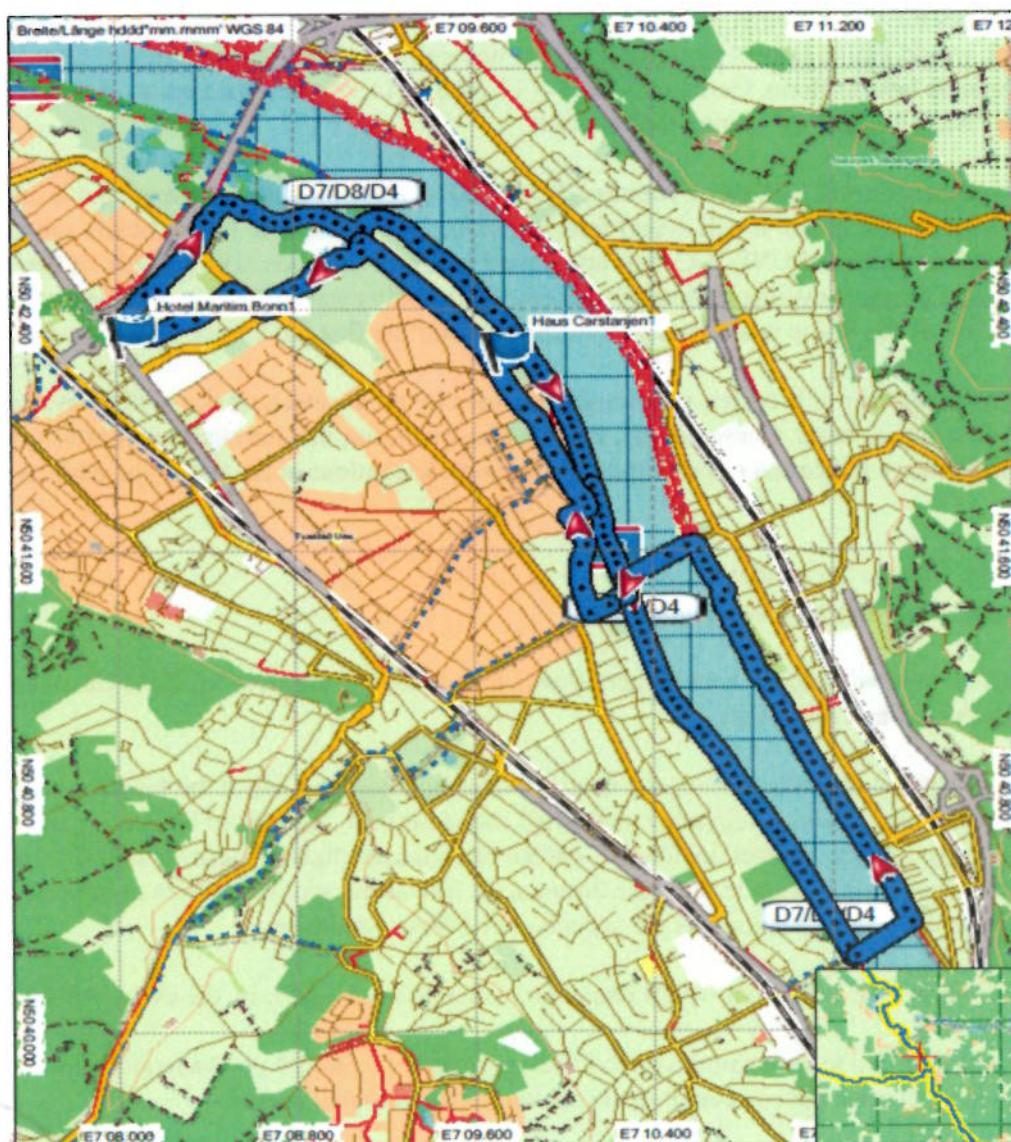

2. Travel Rhine upwards to Mehlem Ferry
3. Cross over Rhine via Mehlem Ferry
4. Travel Rhine downwards to Ferry Bad Godesberg / Oberdollendorf
5. Cross over Rhine via Ferry Bad Godesberg / Oberdollendorf
6. Travel Rhine downward to Haus Carstagen
7. Stop-over at Haus Carstagen
8. Travel Back to Maritim Hotel
