Pursuant to the conclusions of the SBSTA on research and systematic observation at its thirty-seventh and thirty-eighth sessions, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations that the workshop on technical and scientific aspects of ecosystems with high-carbon reservoirs not covered by other agenda items under the Convention will take place in Bonn, Germany from 24 to 25 October 2013.
