

## Like-Minded Developing Countries' Views on Article 6.2

### Principles

- PA's bottom-up approach
- Embracing NDC/SD diversity
- Fostering cooperation
- Prioritizing NDC implementation

## Provisions

- NDC (strategic)
- Sustainable development (strategic)
- Environmental integrity (facilitative)
- Transparency (facilitative)
- Accounting (facilitative)
  
- The strategic (nationally defined) should not be limited by the facilitative

## Scope (of Facilitative Provisions)

- Transfers (not mitigation generation)
- Transfers unique to Article 6
- Mitigation generation
  - Addressed elsewhere in PA (w/similar provisions)
  - Nationally decided (NDC)

## Mitigation Outcomes

- Not unique to Article 6.2, addressed elsewhere
- Need to avoid duplication (environmental integrity, transparency, accounting...)
- Need full spectrum of mitigation outcomes, including:
  - Emission avoidance
  - Co-benefits of adaptation including economic diversification
- Accommodation of various metrics

## Sustainable Development

- Inherently bottom-up
- Promotion: active and protective means
- Active: national prerogative through authorization
- Protective:
  - Negative socio-economic impacts
  - Manageable sustainable development transition
- For Article 6.2, focus on transfers

## Supplementarity

- PA grounded in domestic action
- Article 6.2 risks augmenting this
- Unbound use of Article 6.2 risks undue advantages
- Use of ITMOs should be supplemental to domestic action

## Share of Proceeds

- Apply share of proceeds to Article 6.2 activities
- Channel proceeds to Adaptation Fund
- Aims:
  - Ensure that Article 6.4 activities are not unduly disadvantaged
  - Further adaptation support for developing countries
