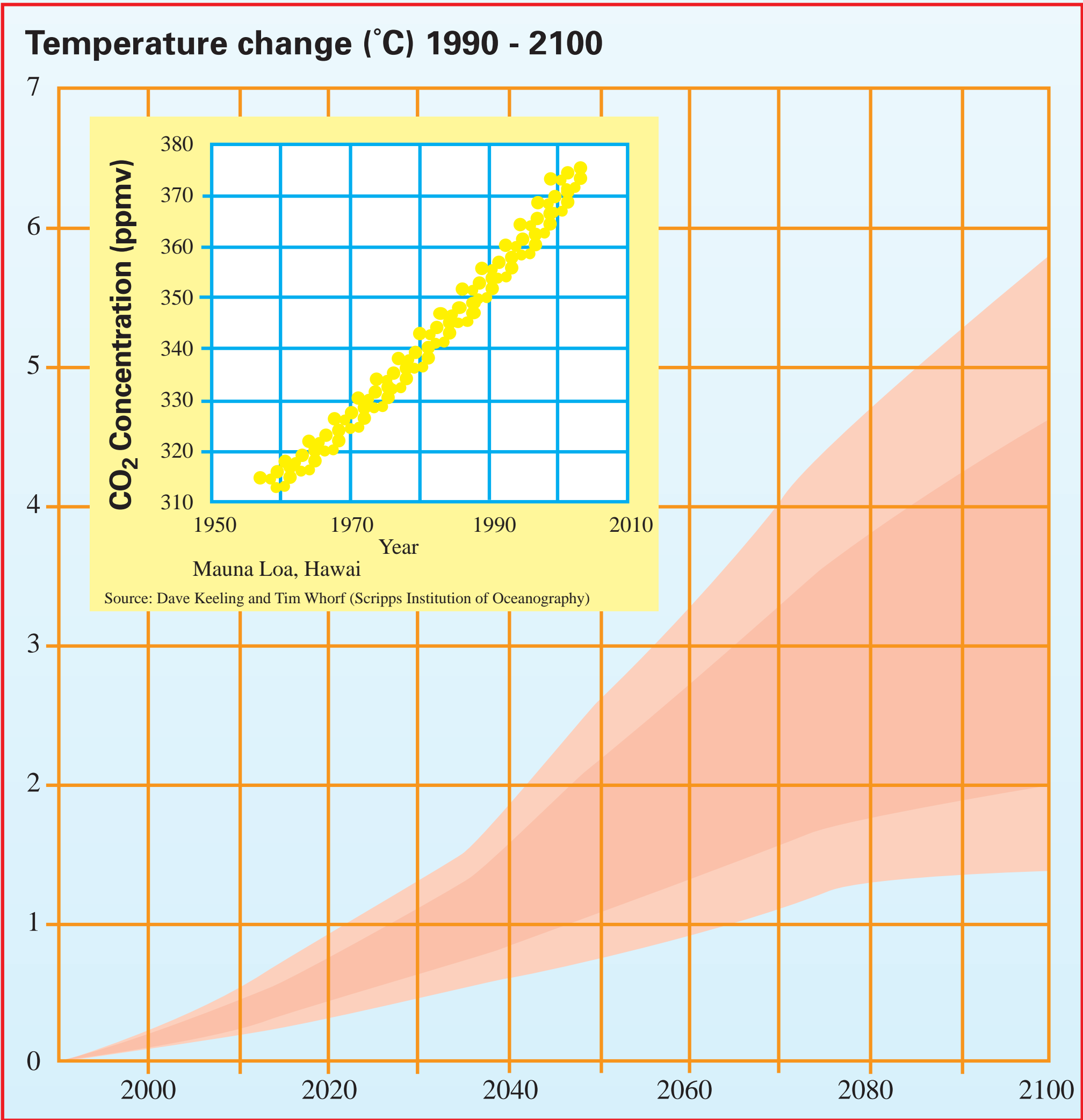


Climate is changing
