Workshop on issues related to Articles 5, 7 and 8 of the Kyoto Protocol

14 - 16 March, Bonn

Venue, Date and Time

The workshop is being held in the Internationales Kongresszentrum Bundeshaus Bonn, Görresstrasse 15, 53113 on 14 –16 March 2000. The workshop rooms are located in three separate buildings (see plan). The Plenary is the *Pumpenhaus* which is outside the main building, and the other smaller meeting rooms are the *Rhein* room (P 2.7), the *Little Rhein* room (P1.10) and the *Square* room (D) in the main building (see plan).

Registration will be from 8.00 - 9.00 on 14 March at the registration desk in the main foyer of the Internationales Kongresszentrum Bundeshaus Bonn.

The workshop meetings are scheduled from 9:00 – 13:00 & 14:30 – 18:00 on Tuesday, 14 March from 9:00 - 13:00 and 14:30 – 18:00 on Wednesday, 15 March and 9:00 – 13:00 and from 14:30 until circa 16:30 on Thursday 16 March.

Documents

Communications

Telephones are located in the main foyer. There are also computers with internet access for the participants in Room F.

Cloakroom

Coat stands will be available near the meeting rooms and toilets are located in the foyer near the main meeting room.

Catering

There will be a coffee bar in the foyer of the main building which will have coffee and cold snacks during the breaks.

During lunchtime, participants may have lunch at the cafeteria on the 29th floor of the adjacent building, *Langer Eugen*. In order to be served more quickly, participants are advised to go after 13:00.

Alternatively participants may like to take a short 10 minute walk along Heussallee to the Federal Art Museum and Gallery (*Kunstmuseum and Kunst und Ausstellungshalle*) and the adjacent German History Museum (*Haus der Geschichte*) on

Friedrich Ebert Allee and Adenauer Allee. Both have pleasant cafeteria with wide choices of food. A plan is included for your assistance.
