Draft conclusions proposed by the Chairs

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) convened a meeting of the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures at these sessions in accordance with the decisions 7/CMA.1, 7/CP.24 and 3/CMP.14.
2. The SBSTA and the SBI adopted the six-year workplan of the forum and the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI), contained in the annex.
3. The SBSTA and the SBI agreed that, at each of its meetings, the KCI shall discuss the necessary arrangements for the activity being conducted at the subsequent two meetings of the SBI and SBSTA by the forum and its KCI, using the modalities set out in the six-year work plan of the forum and its KCI.
4. The SBSTA and the SBI considered the annual report¹ on the work of the KCI capturing the outcomes of key activities of the KCI in 2019 and requested the forum to consider the issues identified by the KCI for the forum's considerations contained in this annual report at the fifty sixth session of the subsidiary bodies (June 2020).
5. The SBSTA and SBI recommended the rules of procedures of the KCI for consideration and adoption by the COP, CMP and CMA.
6. The SBSTA and the SBI, having considered the recommendations from the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures convened during the sessions, recommended draft decisions for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-fifth session, the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its fifteenth session, and the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement at its second session (for the text of the draft decisions, see document FCCC/SB/2019/L.X/Add.X-X).
7. The SBSTA and the SBI requested the secretariat to facilitate the implementation of the workplan of the forum and its KCI referred to in paragraph 2 above.
8. The SBSTA and the SBI took note of the estimated budgetary implications of the activities to be undertaken by the secretariat referred to in paragraphs xxx above.
9. They requested that the actions of the secretariat called for in these conclusions be undertaken subject to the availability of financial resources.

Elements of draft decisions

Decision -/CMA.2

The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement,

Recalling decisions 7/CMA.1, 3/CMP.14 and 7/CP.24,

1. *Welcomes* the annual report of the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures² and its progress in supporting the work of the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures;
2. *Adopts* the rules of procedure of the Katowice Committee of Experts as contained in annex;
3. *Welcomes* the adoption of the work plan of the forum and its KCI by the SBSTA and the SBI at their twenty fifth sessions.
4. *Requests* the SBSTA and the SBI to consider:
 - (a) Developing methodologies and tools, including modelling tools, for the assessment and analysis of the impacts of the implementation of response measures in consultation with technical experts, practitioners and other relevant stakeholders, as appropriate;
 - (b) Building capacity for development and deployment of methodologies and tools, in particular of developing country parties, to inform and support national climate change mitigation and sustainable development priorities and policies;
 - (c) Developing more national, regional and sector-specific case studies involving the assessment and analysis of the impacts of the implementation of response measures to enable an exchange of experience among Parties.
