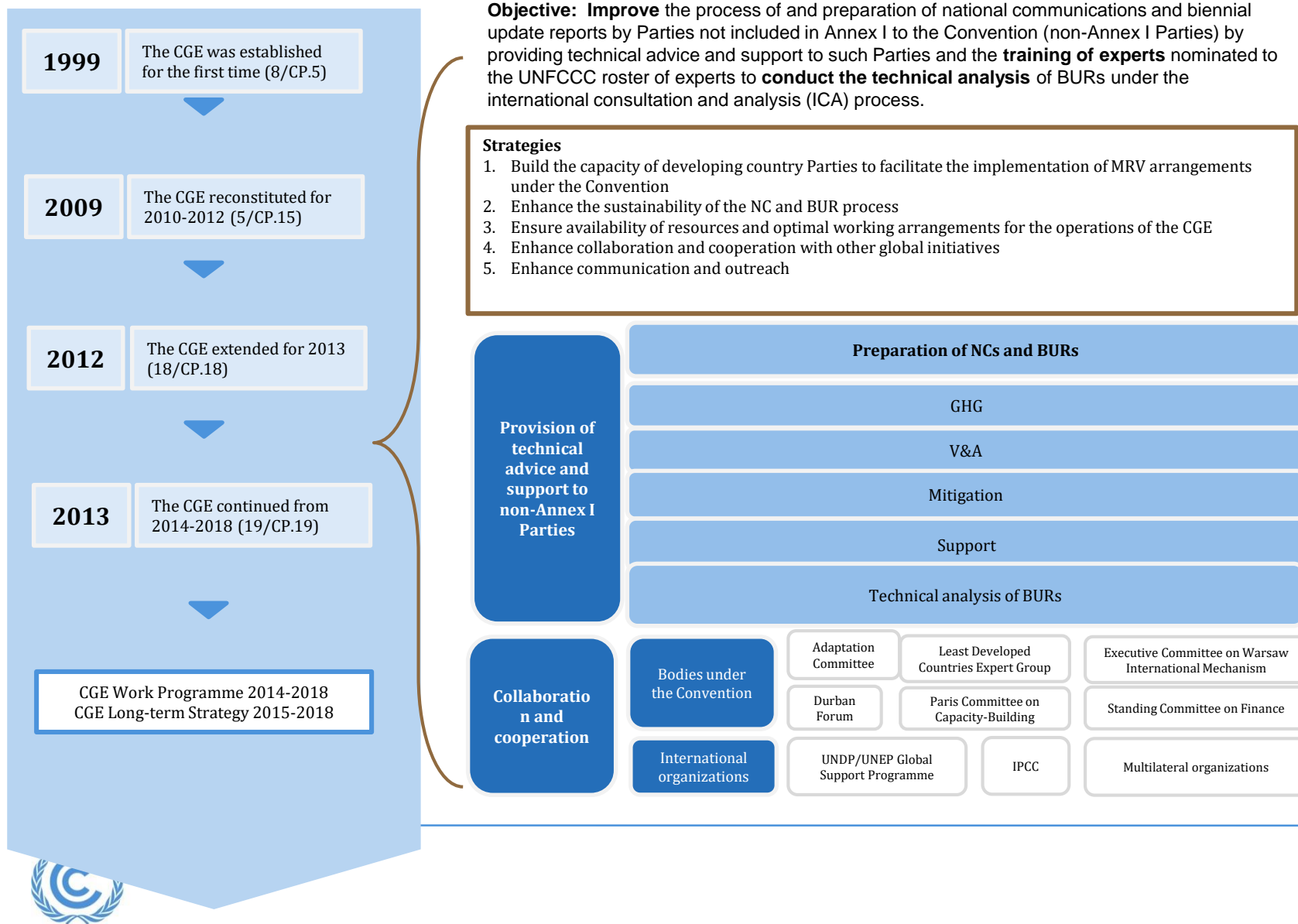

Vulnerability and adaptation

- **Training materials** covers implications of climate change on agriculture.
 - ✓ Methodologies, tools and associated data collection and management that are commonly used in the agricultural sector for vulnerability and adaptation (V&A) assessment.
- 2018 **hands-on training workshop included a sectoral** session provided in-depth look at the drivers of change in agriculture, methods, tools, data requirements, economic models and integrated assessment, case study, and examples of cost-benefit analysis, and identification of selection of adaptation options.

- Case studies also included on: Conducting a mitigation assessment to determine mitigation options to inform policies, strategies and measures at the regional, national or local levels
- *CGE Webinar - Global Greenhouse Gas Mitigation Potential in Agriculture*
 - ✓ In collaboration with FAO, the webinar focused on the agriculture sector within the climate change context to reduce emissions and to adapt to a changing and more variable climate and reporting information in this regard in national communications and biennial update reports

- **CGE** participated as resource persons to the workshops organized by the secretariat on the 2006 IPCC guidelines
