Aim of the Paris Committee on Capacity-building

“... to address gaps and needs, both current and emerging, in implementing capacity-building in developing country Parties and further enhance capacity-building efforts, including with regard to coherence and coordination in capacity-building activities under the Convention.” (1/CP.21, paragraph 71)

Work plan

The PCCB has been tasked with overseeing and managing the **2016-2020 capacity-building workplan** launched by COP 21, which encompasses **nine areas**.

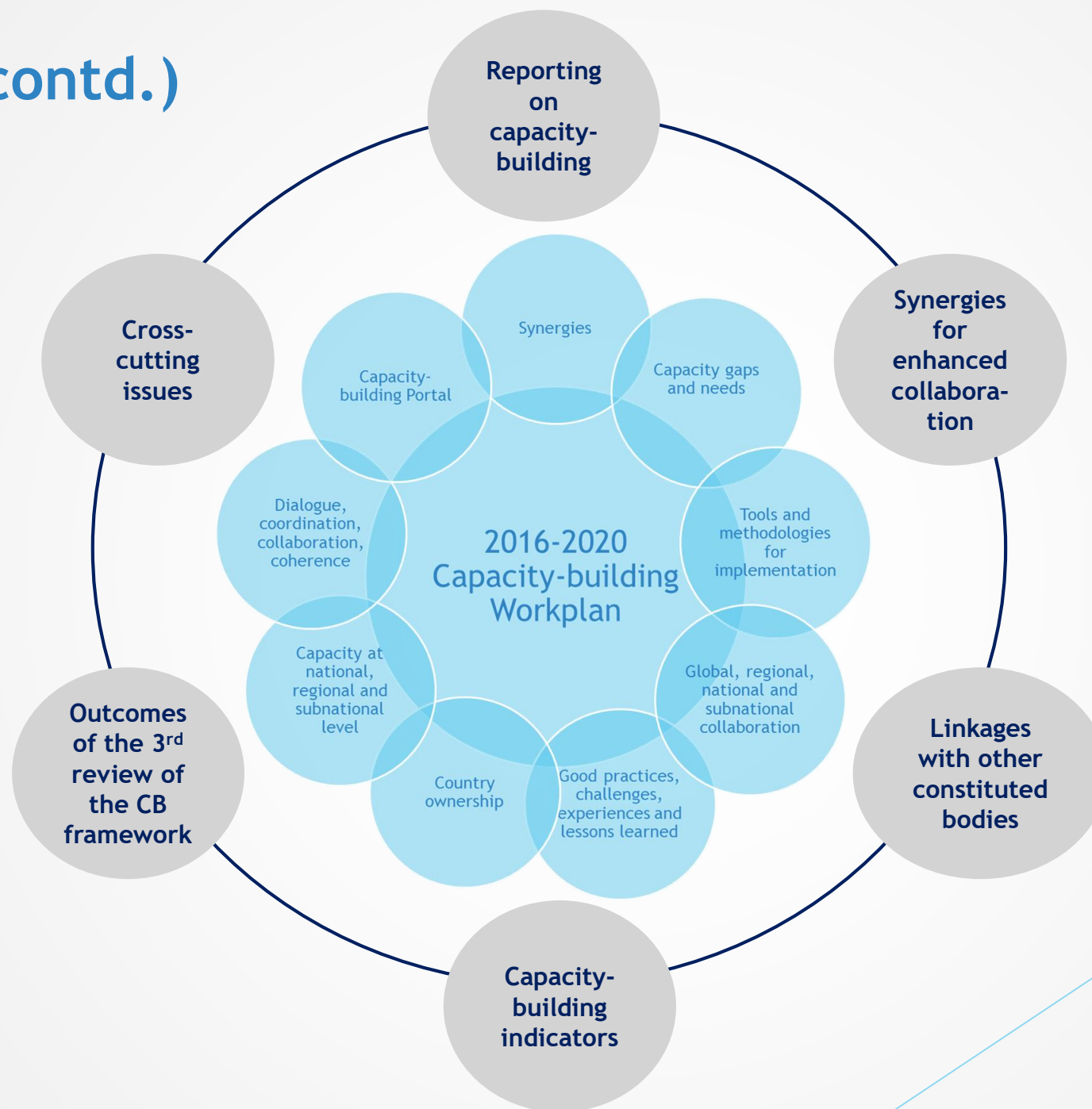

Work plan (contd.)

- ▶ Based on its aim and mandates, the PCCB adopted a **rolling work plan for the period 2017-2019**;
- ▶ Implemented through the lens of the **PCCB's annual focus area or theme** (2017-2019 focus area: Capacity-building activities for the implementation of NDCs);
- ▶ Supported through **four thematic PCCB working groups** focused on:

Strengthening linkages

with the constituted bodies and relevant processes and initiatives under and outside the Convention

Cross-cutting issues

such as gender responsiveness, human rights, and indigenous peoples' knowledge

Mandate

Identifying capacity gaps and needs

- Collaborate with other stakeholders to identify and assess agriculture related capacity gaps and capacity-building needs in the context of NDC implementation (in line with the PCCB focus area for 2019)
- Develop capacity-building focused policy recommendations for consideration by the COP

Ideas for supporting the work under the KJWA roadmap

Mandate

Increasing synergies and avoiding duplication with the constituted bodies under the Convention

- Implement collaborative activities with other constituted bodies; e.g. joint policy briefs with the TEC and SCF relating to means of implementation for agriculture-related activities

Ideas for supporting the work under the KJWA roadmap

Mandates

Promoting dialogue, coordination, collaboration and coherence among processes and initiatives under the Convention / Fostering global, regional, national and subnational collaboration

- Consider activities in the context of the PCCB collaboration with the Marrakech Partnership for Global Climate Action (e.g. at the regional climate weeks)
- Promote and convene events at regional and/or global level to foster South-South and South-North knowledge-sharing, collaboration and coordination among universities

Ideas for supporting the work under the KJWA roadmap

Mandate

Strengthening capacity at national, regional and subnational level

- Organize collaborative activities with national capacity institutions (i.e. through the University Network on Climate Change - UNCC) to push for effective capacity utilization
- Organize regional capacity-building days in collaboration with universities (i.e. in the context of regional climate weeks)

Ideas for supporting the work under the KJWA roadmap

Mandate

Identifying and collecting good practices, challenges, experiences and lessons learned

- Share relevant knowledge and information on the web-based Capacity-Building Portal
- Disseminate relevant knowledge and information on the PCCB's digital Capacity-building Hub on Facebook
- Raise awareness and facilitate the sharing of knowledge through organizing agriculture-themed events at annual Capacity-building - Series of Events of the PCCB at the COPs
- Consider agriculture-related sessions at future meetings of the annual Durban Forum on Capacity-building
