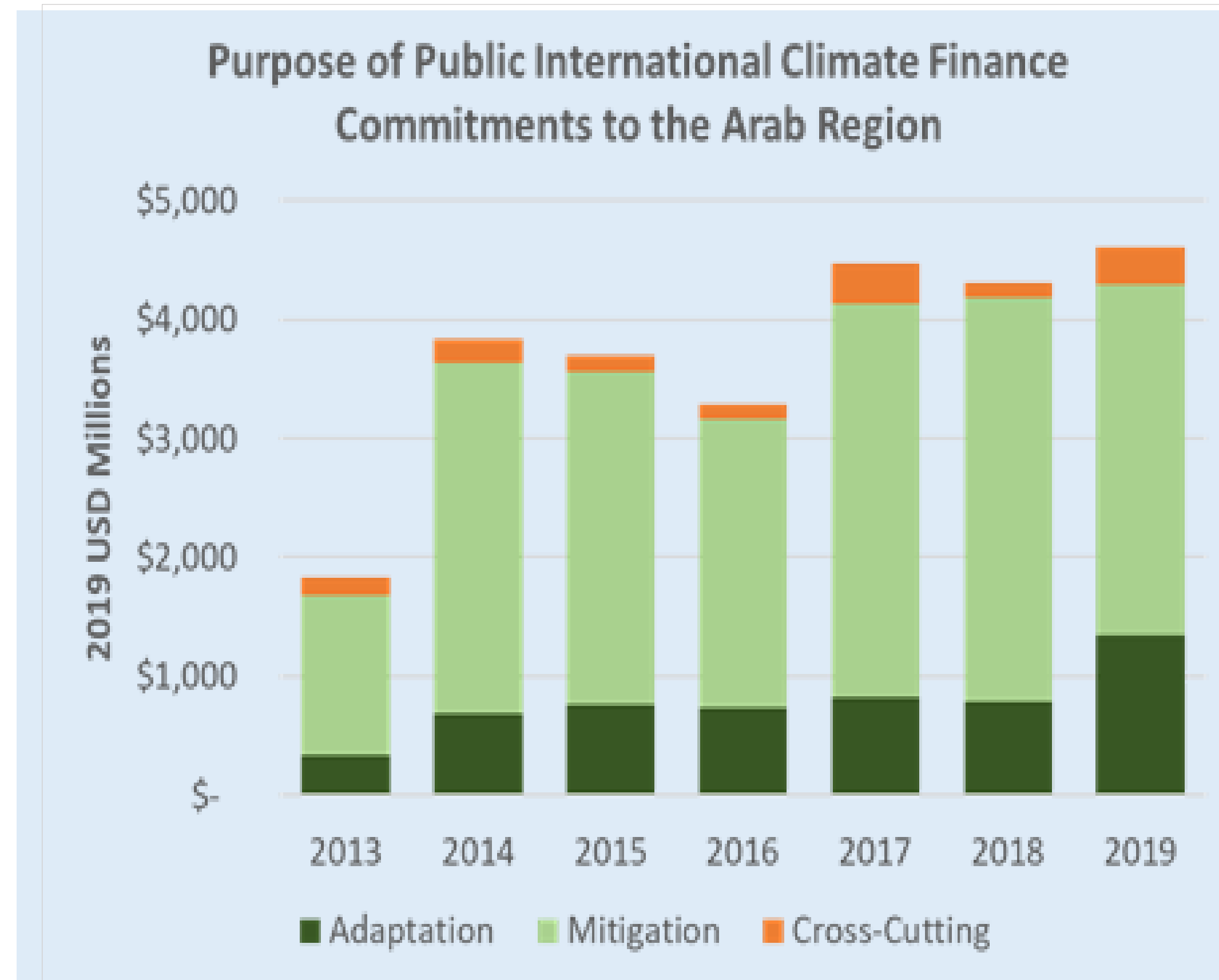


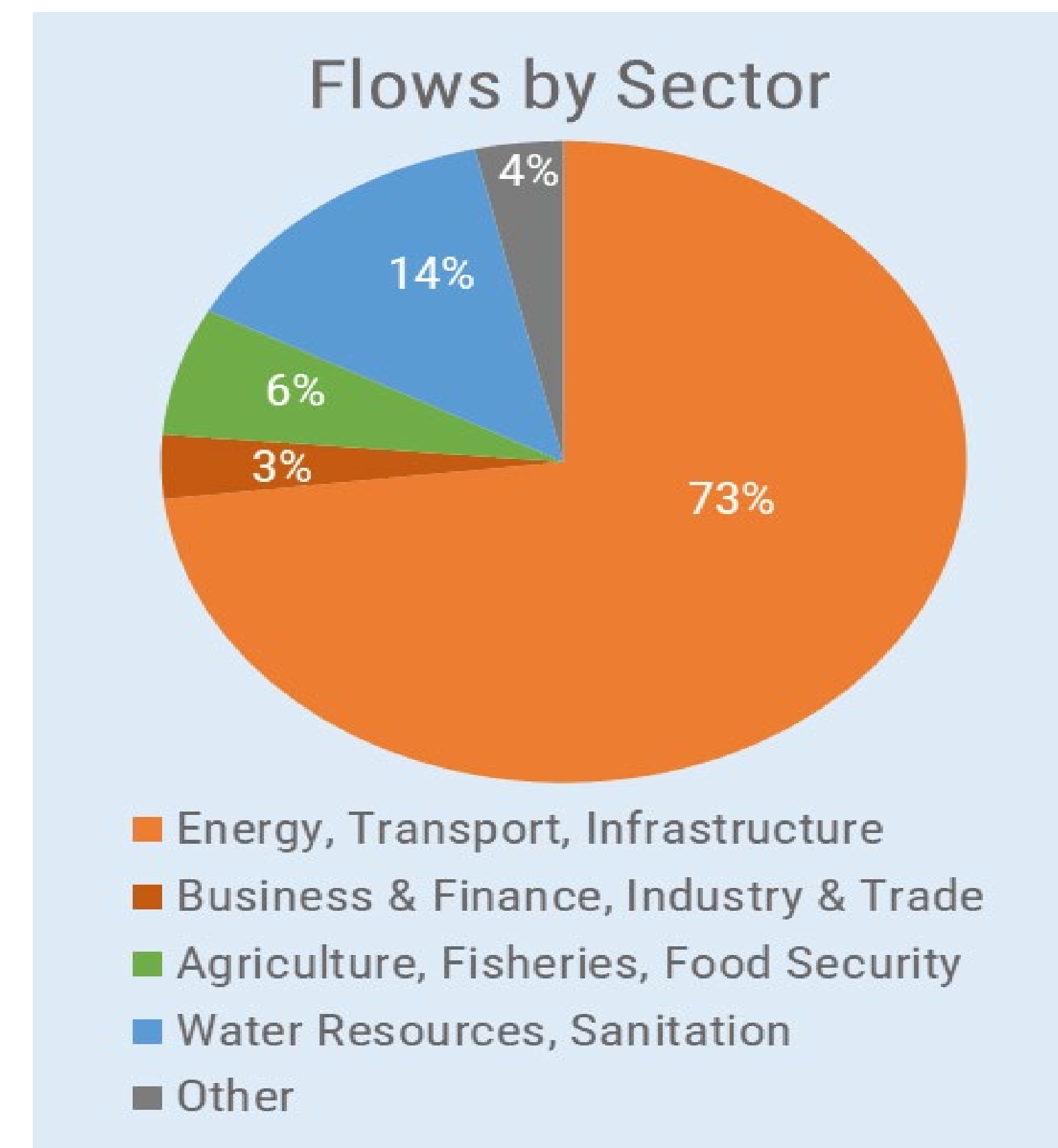
Mobilizing Climate Finance in the Arab Region

Climate Finance Flows to Arab Region

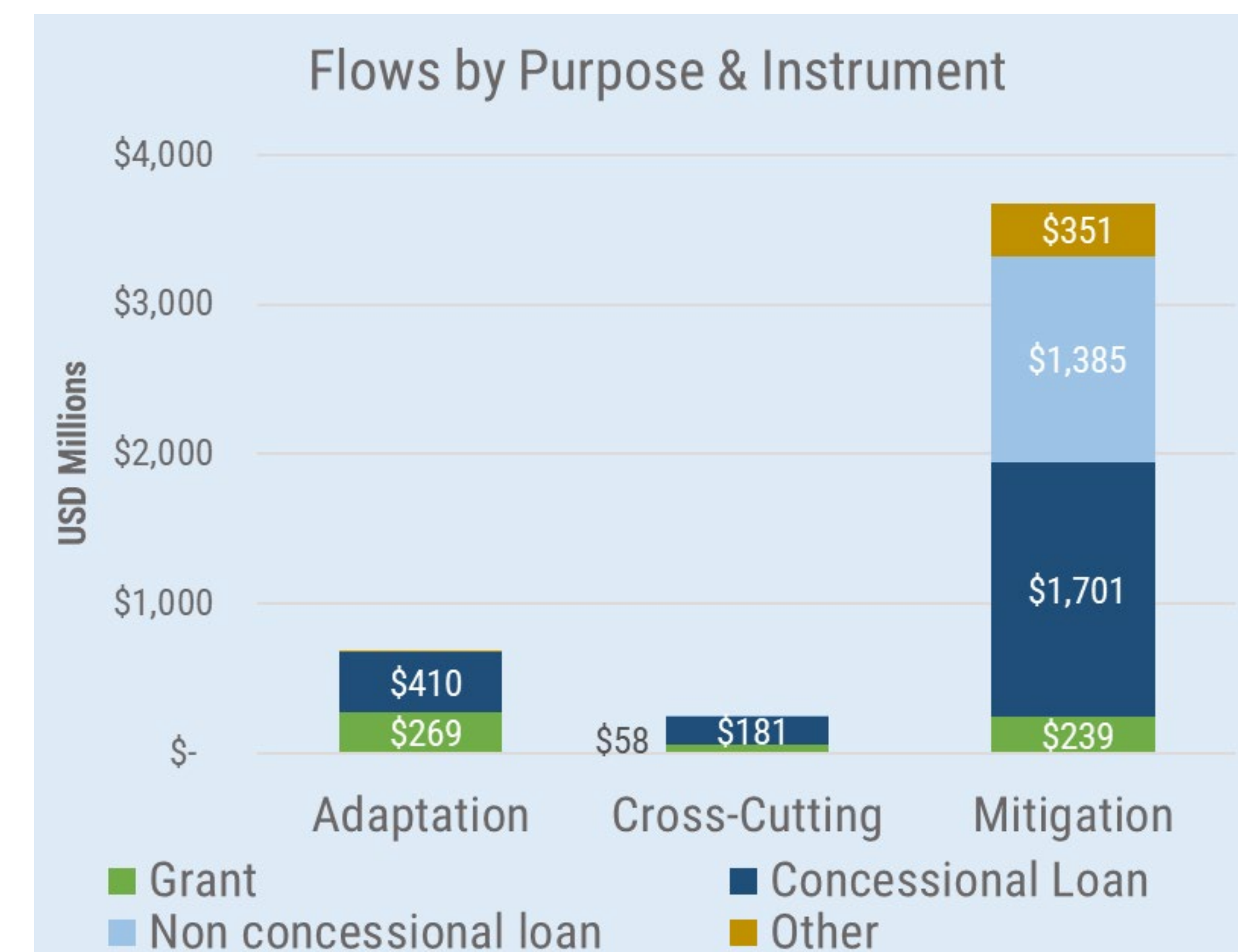
Adaptation is the priority for Arab States. Yet the region receive 3.5 times more climate finance for mitigation than adaptation (2013-2019).



Support is not reaching the most vulnerable: 6 Arab LDCs received just 5% of total commitments and 18% of adaptation commitments.



The Arab Region received 8.5 times more debt finance than grants for climate action (2013-2019).

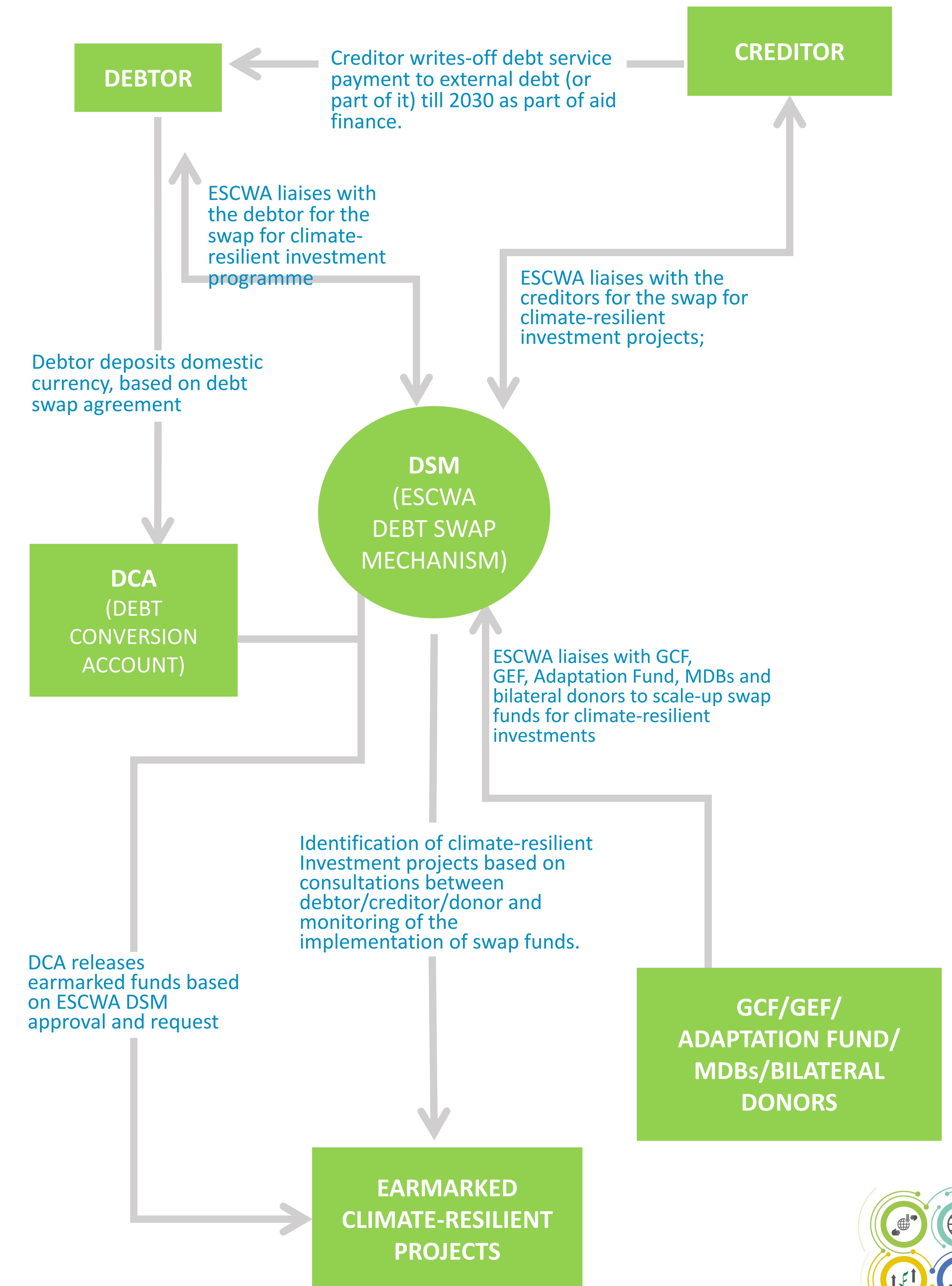


The quantity and quality of climate finance must thus be improved

ESCWA launched this regional Debt Swap initiative in 2020 to support middle-income countries with high debt burdens.

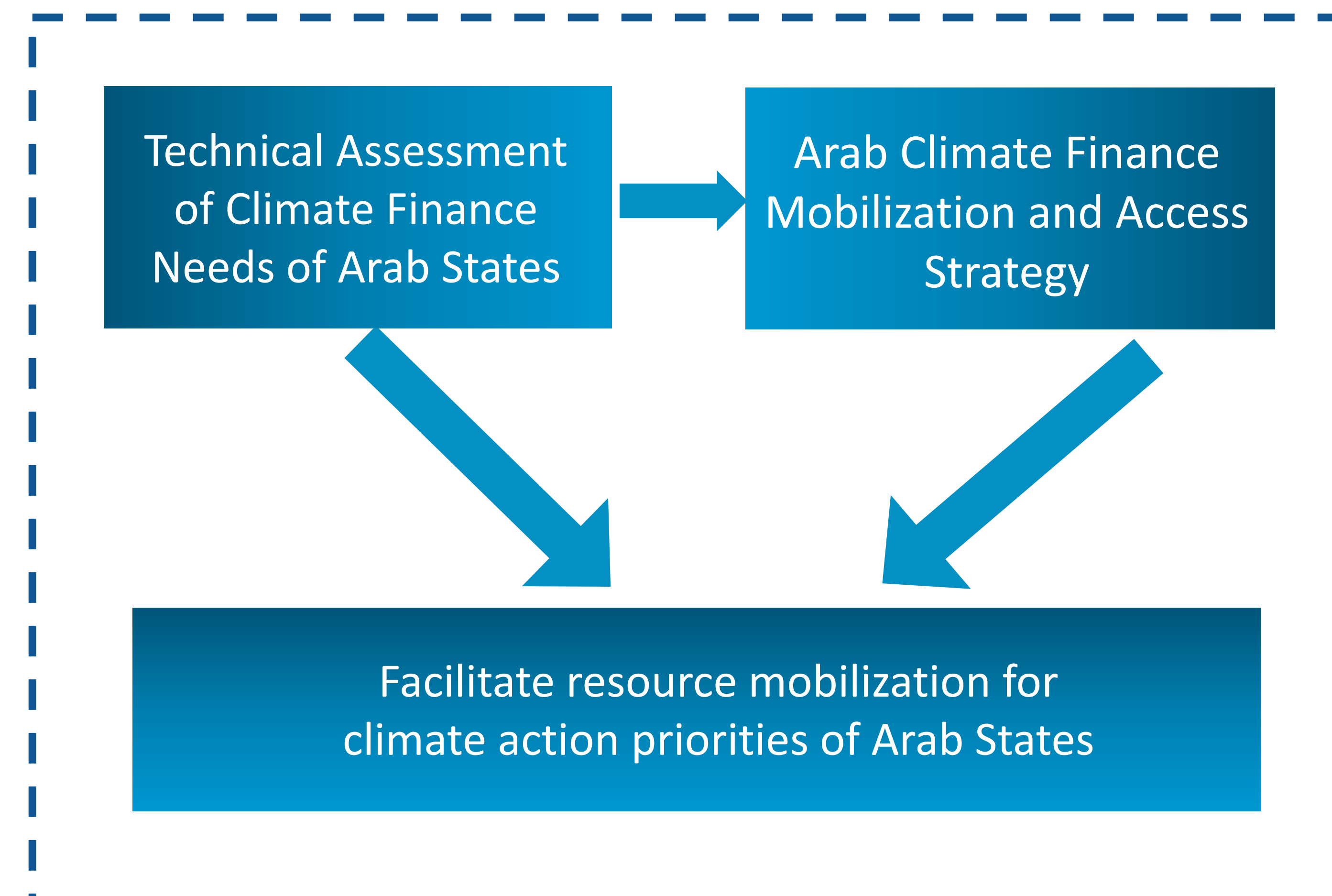


Arab Climate Finance Mobilization and Access Strategy
