<p>ACM0012 “Consolidated baseline methodology for GHG emission reductions from waste energy recovery projects” is applicable to the recovery and use of waste gas from industrial facilities that otherwise will be flared or released to the atmosphere in the absence of the project activity.</p> <p>The request for revision seeks to allow the generation of heat prior the implementation of the project activity provided that the heat generation in the project activity is no less than heat generated prior to the project activity.</p>

<p>The second bullet point regarding the applicability condition or Type-2 project activities in the version 03.2 of the methodology ACM0012 states that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The portion of waste gas captured prior to implementation of the project activity is used for generation of captive electricity. The use of a portion of the waste gas in the baseline for the purpose of heat generation or other use prior to implementation of the project activity is also permitted under this methodology provided the generation of heat or other use in the crediting period remain same as that in the baseline. <p>This means the situation presented in the request for revision is already addressed by the methodology.</p>
